Austin Roberts graduated from West Caldwell High School in 2015. While at West, Austin was an active member of the NROTC Program for three years. Having a strong work ethic, Austin also worked at MDI Inc. throughout his high school years and after graduating.

Who is Eligible?

The Austin Roberts Memorial Scholarship is open to applicants of West Caldwell High School seniors and members of West Caldwell's NROTC program wishing to attend an institute of higher learning. Applicants must be US citizens and must meet requirements for admissions to an institute of higher learning of their choice. Consideration is given to all students regardless of race or religious affiliation who show academic promise and leadership qualities. Final decisions are based on the OVERALL student, not high grade point averages or high SAT scores.

- 1. Application questions may be reproduced in a word document. If answers are not legible, the application will not be considered.
- 1. Include the following:
 - a. Official transcript
 - b. Letter of recommendation from teacher/principal
 - c. Typed Essay-found on bottom of page (4) four
