Having lived and worked in Caldwell County for most of their lives, the Bernhardts understand how education can positively affect one's life and future health and happiness.

Education helps to give the ability to think critically, to develop self-awareness and to build communication skills. Scholarship provides knowledge of the world and changes the learner into a productive individual who contributes to volunteerism and philanthropy.

All students from Caldwell County Schools High Schools are eligible to apply who can demonstrate outstanding work ethics, leadership qualities and who have a history of philanthropic service. Final decisions by the Education Foundation selection committee are based on a student's financial need, academic achievement, leadership ability and philanthropic service.

Note: The Anne and Alex Bernhardt Scholarship is renewable for the recipient who stays in good standing throughout his/her undergraduate years.
