## Who is Eligible?

The Austin Roberts Memorial Scholarship is open to applicants of West Caldwell High School seniors wishing to attend an institute of higher learning. Applicants must be US citizens and must meet requirements for admissions to an institute of higher learning of their choice. Consideration is given to all students regardless of race or religious affiliation who show academic promise and leadership qualities. Final decisions are based on the OVERALL student, not high grade point averages or high SAT scores.

  - a. Official transcript
  - b. Letter of recommendation from teacher/principal
