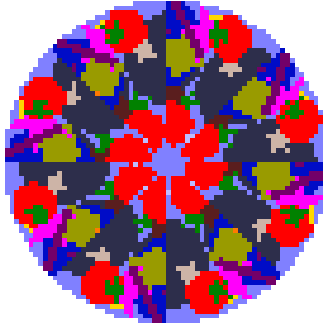


Kaleidoscope 2027

K-12 Logo Submissions



Guidelines

The Education Foundation is holding the annual student Kaleidoscope Logo search. The selected entry will be used on the Education Foundation's Kaleidoscope 2027 tickets, press releases and program as needed.

All Caldwell County students, grades K-12 are eligible to participate.

Students must adhere to the following guidelines to be eligible for the selection phase of the competition:

- Entries are **not required** to have the caption ***Kaleidoscope 2027***, but are *encouraged to do so if the caption works into the art*.
- All art must maintain a theme pertaining to a/all performing art(s) or visual art(s). Entries can include one or more of the performing arts represented at Kaleidoscope: dance, drama, music, vocal, and performance artists such as magicians, jugglers, etc.
- Only one entry is allowed per student.
- Each school may submit up to 25 entries.
- There is not a size limitation or requirement. There is not a color limit or media restriction.
- Entries should have the name of student/school and grade **on back** of art work in a way that does not show through the front of the art. Possibly use a label to print/write name, grade and school so the ink does not bleed through.

Deadline for art is **December 11, 2026** no later than 5:00 p.m.

Please deliver to the Education Foundation.

One entry will be selected for the Kaleidoscope 2027 logo.

A cash award of \$500.00 will go to the winner's school's art department.

Winner will receive a logo prize and tickets to the show for family.

Entries will be returned. The selected entry will be displayed at the Education Foundation and a copy will be provided to the winner.
